Battlefields of the Western Front

The battles which took place in Flanders and the Somme from 1914–18 were on a massive scale and left countless thousands dead. Our tour is based near Ypres, perhaps the war's most famous site, and is well placed for touring Flanders and The Somme. Our 4 star hotel is in Menen, a charming market town a short drive from Ypres.

Tour Itinerary

Day 1 Channel crossing and on to Flanders.

Day 2 Ypres is a thriving historic town that was devastated during some of the bloodiest battles of 1917/18. See the 'In Flanders Fields Museum' (admission costs not included), the Menen Gate and nearby Tyne Cot, the largest British war cemetery. We can, on request, arrange a late evening meal after the daily Last Post Ceremony at the Menen Gate (8pm).

Day 3 A full day to the Somme, in France. See the Thiepval Memorial and Beaumont Hamel Memorial Park with the 'danger tree' and trench system. Return via the Canadian Memorial and Vimy Ridge.

Day 4 Depart and journey home.
