Tour itinerary

Day 1 Journey north to the hotel in the centre of Carlisle. If time permits we can arrange a trip on the Lancaster Canal en-route. Contact us for details.

Day 2 Welcome to Carlisle. A local guide will provide an introductory tour of the city before time at leisure to explore such attractions as Carlisle Castle and the Cathedral with its 14th century stained glass window and magnificent ceiling. There is also excellent shopping in The Lanes complex and the refurbished Victorian Market Hall.

Day 3 Travel through the impressive scenery of the Northumberland National Park with views of Hadrian's

Wall. We recommend a stop in the delightful town of Corbridge with its pretty shops and cafes. Continue across the border into Scotland for a visit to Jedburgh before returning to Carlisle.

Day 4 Full day excursion to the Lake District. Follow a circular route taking in the region's most scenic locations from Ullswater to Windermere and Ambleside to Keswick. A local guide can be arranged for an extra charge of approximately £4 pp.

Day 5 Board the Carlisle to Settle railway for a journey through the Eden Valley and onwards across the Yorkshire Dales. Rejoin the coach in Settle and continue homeward.
