Limerick and Killarney Experience



We use Limerick as a tour base for scenic excursions to Killarney and the Ring of Kerry plus the spectacular Cliffs of Moher, by using the convenient Shannon Ferries to cross Clonderlaw Bay.

Tour Itinerary

Day 1 Afternoon sea crossing from North Wales, then to overnight stop in the Dublin area. Tour can be amended for crossings via Scotland or South Wales if preferred.

Day 2 Journey towards Limerick via the ancient town of Birr with its famous castle, then follow the beautiful Lough Derg drive to Killaloe. Free time in Limerick before continuing to the hotel.

Day 3 Full day excursion to Killarney, stopping first at Ladies View, one of the most impressive viewpoints on the Ring of Kerry, then free time in this delightful town.

Day 4 Another full day starting with a visit to The Foynes Flying Boat Museum, which recalls the era from 1939 to 1945 when Foynes was the centre of the aviation world

for air traffic between the US and Europe. Foynes is also famous for being the birthplace of Irish Coffee. Continue with a ferry crossing of the Shannon and follow the coastline to the spectacular Cliffs of Moher. The Visitor Centre provides superb facilities and panoramic views of the cliffs and Liscannor Bay. Return to Limerick via a circular route.

Day 5 Depart Limerick after breakfast and head to Dublin. Enjoy an afternoon at leisure before checking in to the overnight hotel. A guided city tour can be arranged, ask us for details.

Day 6 Morning ferry crossing and homeward journey.
