The small town of Vianden has a picturesque location on the banks of the River Our, set amidst magnificent Luxembourg scenery, close to the border with Germany. Vianden houses many great buildings including a feudal manor, a former Trinitarian church and cloister and a rural art museum. Our popular 3 star hotel is close to the centre of Vianden.

Tour Itinerary

Day 1 Short Channel crossing. Scenic drive through the Ardennes to Luxembourg for a 4 night stay.

Day 2 Excursion to Grevenmacher on the River Mosel. Set in splendid scenery Grevenmacher is an important wine-growing centre. A wine tasting and/or boat trip can be arranged on request.

Day 3 Full day excursion to Luxembourg city. We suggest a half day guided tour followed by time at leisure. Sights

include Luxembourg Castle Ruins, the Grand Ducal Palace and Cathedral of Notre-Dame. (Admissions not included.)

Day 4 Full day excursion to Trier, the oldest city in Germany. Once the regional Roman capital, it offers a host of well preserved reminders of bygone days, with its amphitheatre and thermal baths.

Day 5 Depart Luxembourg. Time allowing, stop in medieval Brugge en route to Calais and home.
