for a scenic journey on the, fully restored, Severn Valley Railway. Disembark at Bridgnorth and continue north for a visit to the Ironbridge Gorge Museum. The included passport ticket allows entry to all of the attractions including Blists Hill Victorian Town where costumed staff offer a fascinating insight into what life was like in Victorian Times.

Day 4 Homeward journey via a recommended stop in the cathedral city of Worcester.
