NEW Steyr, Vienna and Austria's Romantic Road



The stunning city of Steyr lies on Austria's Romantic Road and at the confluence of the rivers Enns and Steyr. Our 4 star hotel is located at the heart of historic Steyr with a scenic position overlooking the river. This new tour offers the possibility to tour off the beaten track and with a super range of excursions that include Vienna, The Salzkammergut Lakes and the Danube Valley.

Tour Itinerary

Day 1 Channel crossing, overnight in Belgium.

Day 2 Through the Ardennes and Luxembourg and then on to Germany for dinner and an overnight stay.

Day 3 Pass Munich and Salzburg. Time allowing make a refreshment stop in wonderful Mondsee before travelling on to Steyr for a 5 night stay.

Day 4 A full day in Steyr. Explore the narrow streets and alleys and stroll along the riverside on the Enns Quay. This evening we include a special "Night Watchman" tour starting with a champagne reception, guided walk through the town, puppet performance and appetisers at the Steyr Kripperl and finally dinner at the hotel.

Day 5 A full day excursion to Austria's capital, Vienna. See Schönbrunn Palace, Castle Belvedere and St Stephen's Cathedral. (Costs not included.)

Day 6 Today follow the Romantic Road, through Kremsmünster and Pattenbach to Gmunden. From here tour the scenic Salzkammergut Lakes with possible stops in Bad Ischl and St Wolfgang. On then through Mondsee before returning to Steyr.

Day 7 Explore another section of the Romantic Road through the breathtaking Danube Valley. See Enns, Ybbs and a host of pretty riverside towns before arriving in stately Melk. Here we include a guided visit to the famous Melk Abbey and gardens.

Day 8 Depart Steyr and travel to the Stuttgart area for dinner and an overnight stay.

Day 9 To Belgium for dinner and an overnight stay.

Day 10 Short Channel crossing to Dover and home.
