Tour Itinerary

Day 1 Travel to Northern Ireland via Stranraer and transfer to the hotel. Crossings via Holyhead can be arranged on request.

Day 2 Meet your guide for an introductory tour of the city followed by some free time to soak up the atmosphere. This afternoon journey out of the city to Strangford Lough and the town of Newtonards for a tour of Mount Stewart House and Gardens. The exotic landscaped gardens, created by Lady Londonderry in the 1930s, relish in the unique climate of the Ards Peninsula. Return to the hotel with time to pop in to the famous Crown Bar, one of the finest high-Victorian gin palaces in the UK with an ornate interior of colourful tiles, carvings and glass.

Day 3 Full day excursion along the spectacular Antrim Coast via Carnlough and Ballycastle to Bushmills. A visit to Old Bushmills Distillery is included where the 400 year old craft and skills of the triple distillation and ageing process is witnessed followed by a wee taster of Bushmills whiskey. From here continue to the world famous Giant's Causeway and view the honeycombed rock formations. A shuttle bus to the rocks is available for an extra charge paid locally.

Day 4 Morning crossing to Scotland and homeward journey.
