#### Tour Itinerary

**Day 1** Travel to mid Wales with a recommended stop in Hereford.

**Day 2** Morning visit to the nearby market town of Builth Wells before an afternoon guided tour of the Hall at Abbey-Cwm-Hir, a 52 roomed private Victorian mansion whose owners have spent 9 years restoring it to its original splendour. Also enjoy the beautiful walled garden.

**Day 3** A feature of today's excursion is the beautiful mountain scenery of the Brecon Beacons. Stop off in

the market towns of Brecon or Abergavenny before continuing to Hay-on-Wye, famous for its books and speciality produce shops.

**Day 4** Excursion through the Cambrian Mountains with a scenic drive around the Elan Dams. Continue to Devil's Bridge and board the Vale of Rheidol Steam Railway for the hour long journey to Aberystwyth. Enjoy some free time in this seaside resort before returning to the hotel.
