Cochem and the Mosel



The Mosel Valley is characterised by ancient towns, a wonderful mild climate, wooded hills and steep vineyards. From the sparkling river to the dramatic landscape, impressive castles and historic towns, this area is a delight. Tour Itinerary

Day 1 Following a Channel crossing proceed through Belgium and then south, into Germany and on to Cochem in time for dinner.

Day 2 A full day to relax and explore Cochem and its long riverside promenade. See the Old Town with its many historic sites and pretty shops, cafés and restaurants. In the afternoon we include a wine tasting at a winery only a short walk from the hotel.

Day 3 Today we recommend an excursion along the Mosel to Koblenz, where the Mosel meets the mighty Rhine.

Return in time for dinner. We will be pleased to arrange a river cruise on request.

Day 4 A full day excursion travelling along the Mosel with a suggested stop in Bernkastel Kues before arriving at Trier. Time at leisure then on to explore Germany's oldest city before returning to Cochem in the late afternoon.

Day 5 Depart Germany and return to Calais via Belgium. Channel crossing and home.
