Interlaken... 5 Star Luxury in the Bernese Oberland



The 5 star Hotel Beau Rivage is often referred to as the “Grande Dame” of Interlaken. This fine period hotel offers views up onto the Eiger and Jungfrau and yet it is centrally positioned near the Castle and Höhematte Park with its wide tree-lined promenade. Interlaken has been a popular destination for generations and is a great base from which to explore this breathtaking part of Switzerland.

Tour Itinerary

Day 1 Channel crossing and overnight in Reims.

Day 2 Through France, cross into Switzerland and on to Interlaken for a 4 night stay.

Day 3 A full day at leisure to enjoy the wonderful hotel and its excellent facilities. Interlaken has a wide selection of shops, bars, cafés and restaurants and is perfect for some hours relaxation.

Day 4 A full scenic day, travelling via the Brunig Pass, to the small city of Lucerne with its beautiful old town, stylish shops and long lake promenade. Return via

Meiringen where Sherlock Holmes is reputed to have met his death.

Day 5 An excursion to Thun, travelling via the small lakeside town of Spiez. Thun is a beautiful town with a fine hilltop castle and many riverside cafés. In the afternoon return to Interlaken via the dramatic northern shore of the Thunersee.

Day 6 Leave Switzerland, cross the Vosges mountains and stop for dinner and an overnight stay in Reims.

Day 7 To Calais, cross the Channel and home.
