Montreux lies on the south facing shore of Lake Geneva. It has a long lakeside promenade flanked by beautiful gardens with a variety of exotic plants. There are a great range of excursion possibilities around the lake, into the Alps and in the rolling hills around Gruyères.

Tour Itinerary

Day 1 Short Channel crossing. Overnight in France.

Day 2 Continue through France, cross into Switzerland and on to Montreux for a 5 night stay.

Day 3 A full day at leisure in Montreux with time to explore the town and nearby Chillon Castle.

Day 4 A day to explore Lake Geneva. Suggested stops include Lausanne, with its stylish harbour, and Geneva.

Day 5 A full day to the Swiss capital, Bern. Explore the old quarter and see the bear pit.

Day 6 Excursion to Gstaad, which is surrounded by magnificent peaks and lush valleys. From here travel on to the medieval walled town of Gruyères.

Day 7 Leave Switzerland. Overnight in France.

Day 8 Channel crossing and home.
