Tour Itinerary

Day 1 Travel to North Wales with a recommended stop en route in Chester. We can make arrangements for a guided city tour if required.

Day 2 This morning transfer to Porthmadog for a one way journey on the Ffestiniog Railway to Blaenau Ffestiniog. Time to visit the Llechwedd Slate Caverns, a reconstruction of a Victorian Slate Mine, (cost not included), before reboarding the coach for the onward journey via Betws-y-Coed and more spectacular views of Snowdonia National Park.

Day 3 Enjoy a morning ride on the Snowdon Mountain Railway, an exciting 2 hour return journey to Snowdon's

new summit station. Afternoon visit to the Welsh Slate Museum in Llanberis.

Day 4 Today have a truly electrifying experience with a visit to Electric Mountain. See how the awesome power of water is harnessed to generate electricity in Europe's largest man-made cavern. Tour includes a sound and light spectacular before journeying by bus into the Dinorwig Power Station. Afternoon options could include a visit to Caernarfon or the seaside towns of Llandudno and Conwy.

Day 5 Homeward journey via Bala and Llangollen if route permits.
